



OMAHA MAYORAL DEBATE



There are five candidates for Omaha mayor in the April 4th primary election, Ean Mikale, Taylor Royal, Christopher Geary, Heath Mello, and Mayor Jean Stothert. The two top vote getters have been invited to take part in a debate April 14th at the Press Club prior to the general election May 9th. The debate is sponsored by the League of Women Voters of Greater Omaha and the Press Club.

The top two are expected to be Mayor Stothert and Heath Mello.

Mayor Stothert, elected in 2013, is completing her first four year term. Prior to that she served on the Omaha City Council and had served three terms on the Millard Board of Education. She is a graduate of Seattle Pacific University with a Bachelor of Science in nursing.

Heath Mello was elected to the Nebraska legislature in 2008 and served two terms. He was prevented from seeking re-election in 2016 because of term limits. He graduated from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln in 2002 with a degree in political science and served as an aide to U.S Senator Ben Nelson.

The noon hour debate will be recorded by WOWT 6 News and played back in its entirety that evening at 7 p.m. The moderator will be Channel 6 anchor/reporter Brian Mastre. It will also be recorded by KIOS public radio for playback over the noon hour at a later date.
